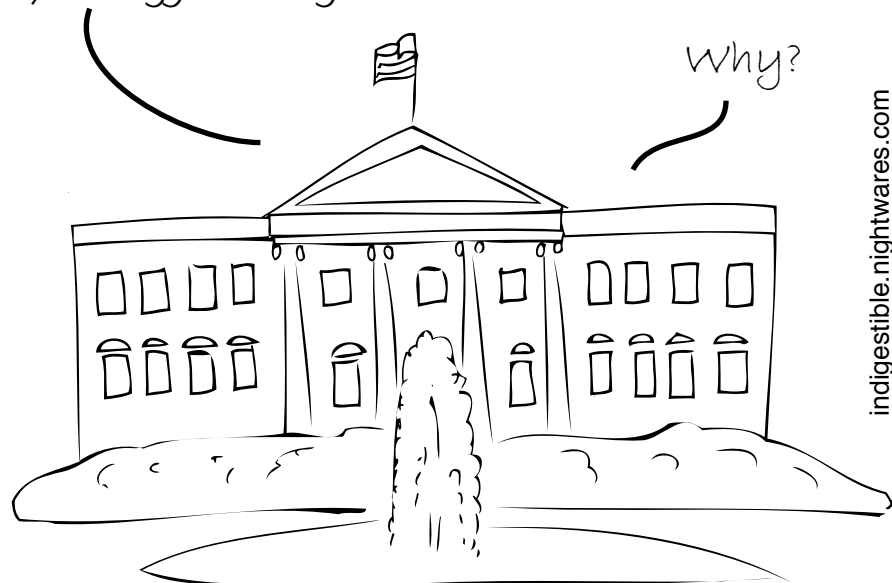


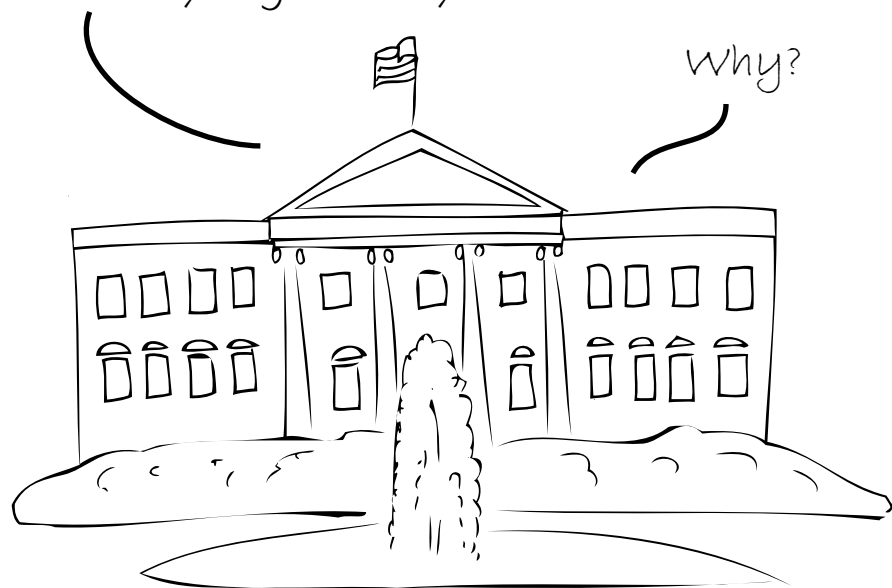
Eat your eggs, Georgie.
